BK obtained his bachelor degree in 1988 from the University of Oklahoma, USA. He worked as a Junior Architect in Di Fiore & Giacobbe Associates in New York until 1990. He was involved in the preparation of construction drawings for various condominiums, a medical office, a shopping complex, and various low-rise housing schemes.

He obtained his Master in Urban Planning from University of Oklahoma, Tulsa, Oklahoma while working in AD Group. As Architect in charge, he worked on all the phases from design to construction for several restaurants, warehouses, and private residences.

On his return to Malaysia, BK joined MAA Architects Sdn. Bhd. in 1995. He was engaged as the architect in the coordination and construction of the Main Terminal Building and Contact Piers for KLIA.

BK then spent about two years with Akitek Axis where he became the Project Architect for three blocks of 22 Storey condominiums, shop-offices, housings and a mixed-use development project.

From 1997 to 1998, BK was employed by Veritas Architects as the Resident Architect for MAS cargo agent facilities at KLIA. While performing his normal routine, he also carried out QA/QC role to ensure work carried out as specified by the consultants.

Later part of 1998, BK worked as the exterior work and cladding coordinator for Natcon~Kumagai Joint Venture in the construction of the five stars Mandarin Oriental Hotel in Kuala Lumpur.

He then joined Gas-KL Building Workshop as an urban designer & planning coordinator for their urban development in Yuxi, China until 2000.

As Senior Architect for Arkitek BH Fam, he took charge of projects from bungalows, housings, warehouses to both low and high rise residential buildings.
